1) Team Organiser

Your Team Organiser has registered/re-registered your team and taken the overall responsibility to ensure that all Match Fees are paid promptly and in full by the end of the season. Please help your Team Organiser, by making sure that your fees are paid on time.

2) Match Fees

Match Fees are £35.00/team/match, and unless your team statement is in credit, match fees will be taken by "AutoPayment" from the "Account Holder", which is more often the Team Organiser as they registered/re-registered your team.

If team members would like to pay for matches in advance, so that your Team Organiser is not paying out of their own account for the whole team, **minimum payment MUST BE £35**

3) Umpire Fees

These should be paid directly to one of the umpires **BEFORE YOUR MATCH** and are £10/team/match. The quicker this is done the longer your match will be!

4) Ringers/Ringers Rule

We have our ringers rule and player ratings in place to ensure leagues are fair and competitive to all. If you break them, then there will be consequences. So PLEASE make sure you are clear on the rules. **We have a chart which shows a list of Player Ratings and which Division they can and cannot ring in. Umpires will ask at the beginning of a match who your ringers are plus their player rating and will note this on their score sheet.

5) New Players

If you have a new player wanting to "try out" for the team, then **THEY MUST BE REGISTERED TO NETBALL FUN LEAGUE + HAVE CREATED A PERSONAL PROFILE** and then the Team Organiser should add any new player to your team on the system **before** they play their first match.



6) Conceding Matches

There are financial implications to conceding a match:

With more than 24 hours notice £45 | On the Day.. (before 4pm) £90 | On the Day.. (after 4pm) £120. A team can only concede 1 match per season. **Read the graphic below**

-  You **MUST** use the contact us form on our website to notify us if your team needs to concede a match

-  **DO NOT** contact the Opposing Team
DO NOT Post on Facebook Ringers Pages
-  **NOTE:** You **CAN** play with less than 2 regular players, but it will mean the points will be awarded to the opposition. Finding ringers however, will avoid your team having the above financial penalties.

7) Code of Conduct

We have a code of conduct here at Netball Fun League, which ALL players sign up to when they agree to play in one of our leagues. It can be found on our website, for those of you who are not familiar with it. 8) Accidents/Injuries

In the event of an injury to a player, Netball Fun League have a **first aid kit and ice packs in each of our kit bags at the venues for use during injuries. Please be aware that Umpires are not there to administer first aid, and this is the responsibility of each team to look after any injured players.**

9) Jewellery/Fingernails/Piercings/Fitbits

You must be "MATCH READY" before taking to the court. Fingernails correct length (or suitable gloves on), jewellery/piercings removed, Fitbits covered etc. **Every Umpire Kit Bag has a Nail Kit!** For full info on all this click link below.

Please note: It is the players responsibility to ensure they are match ready. If players are spotted breaking these rules, then the umpires will simply ask them to leave the court until they have removed items or cut nails, and play will continue. So, it is in your best interests to make sure you are match ready

10) League Winners & League Runners Up

At the end of a season the League Winners and League Runners Up Prizes along with Player of the Season awards, will be distributed within 4 weeks of your league finishing. It will not necessarily be on last match of the season. Logistically this is not possible anymore!

If your team are winners of your league, please be prepared to be promoted to a higher division. If you finish bottom of your league, then you also may be required to move down a division. This is the circle of league life!
